Safety Contract

Goal • Review safety procedures in the science classroom, and agree to follow them.

What to Do

- Read this safety contract carefully.
- Place a ✓ beside each safety procedure that you understand and agree to follow.
- If you do not understand a procedure, ask about it.
- Sign the contract and ask your teacher to witness your signature.
- Take this contract home, and ask an adult in your family to review it with you.
- With the adult, discuss any medical conditions you have that may limit your participation in science class. Fill information about these conditions into the space provided.
- Have the adult sign your completed contract.
- Return the completed and signed contract to your teacher.

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 1. Prepare for science activities by reading assigned materials and noting all safety precautions.
 2. Enter the science classroom only if a teacher is in the room.
 3. Use science equipment only when all three of these are true:
a. I have a teacher's permission.
b. A teacher is in the room.
c. I am using it for assigned projects.
 4. Wear safety glasses, gloves, or a lab apron when they are required.
 5. Tie or pin back hair or loose clothing; to tie back or remove jewellery; and to roll up long sleeves while working around science equipment and using hand tools.
 6. Keep my work place clean and uncluttered, putting equipment away properly when I have finished with it.
 7. Follow a teacher's instructions for disposing of waste or broken materials.
 8. Not to talk to, interrupt, or distract a teacher or another student when they are using equipment, tools, or machinery in a science classroom.
 9. Not to run around or treat equipment as if it is a toy.
 10. Check that equipment, power tools, and machinery are switched "off" or "stopped" before using them.
 11. Stay with machinery whenever it is running.
 12. Report any accidents or problems to a teacher <i>immediately</i> .
 13. Use common sense; and ask a teacher if I am not sure how to do something.
 14. Learn where the following safety equipment is located and how to use it: emergency power switches, fire extinguisher, fire blanket, emergency exits, and first aid equipment. Be prepared to use them when required.
