Teaching Suggestions

The Practice Test can be assigned as an in-class or take-home assignment. If it is used as an assessment, use the following guidelines to help you evaluate your students.

Can students do each of the following?

- · recognize and interpret common statistical measures used in the media
- describe examples and uses of indices, and solve problems involving indices
- explain how the media use and misuse statistics
- describe and interpret types of bias
- assess the validity of claims found in the media by performing a critical analysis

As an alternative to the Chapter Test, have students work in pairs to critically analyse an article in a newspaper or on a Web site that misuses statistics.

Have students:

- describe and analyse how the statistics are misused
- provide possible reasons for why the author chose to misrepresent the data
- identify steps that would correct the misuse

Students could prepare a display of the information along with their conclusions. A carousel format can be used to compare each group's analysis with other groups in the class. Use BLM A-12 Group Work Assessment General Scoring Rubric to assist you in assessing your students. Students can use BLM A-11 Group Work Assessment Recording Sheet to assess their partners' performances.
