

When assessing students' ability to make predictions, consider if the student:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> makes observations that are somewhat related to the event <input type="checkbox"/> is able to make limited adaptation of initial prediction <input type="checkbox"/> is able to explain some of the reasons behind predictions 	2
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> is unable to make a prediction based on events <input type="checkbox"/> is unable to adapt or refine predictions <input type="checkbox"/> is unable to explain predictions 	1
