What to Do

- Use this checklist to assist you in organizing a written report of an experiment or investigation.
- Check off each item as you complete it.

Checklist

1. State	e the title and timing of your inquiry.
	Provide title of investigation or experiment.
	Indicate the timing of the investigation or experiment.
	Include your name and the date your write-up is to be handed in.
2. State	e the problem you investigated.
	Clearly state your inquiry problem.
	State your hypothesis.
	Specify your prediction.
3. Desc	cribe the procedure you followed.
	List, in a clear order, the steps in your procedure.
	Identify your inquiry's independent and dependent variables.
	State how you varied and measured your independent variable.
	State how you measured your dependent variable.
	Describe how you tried to keep other actors constant.
	Indicate your strategy for control and how you developed it.
	List safety precautions that you were aware of and followed.
	Suggest some strategies for repeating your investigation or experiment.
	Explain the significance of repeating such trials.
4. Desc	cribe how you recorded data.
	List data recorded in diagrams such as tables, charts, graphs, or flowcharts.
	Provide neat diagrams drawn in pencil. Include titles, labels, ruled lines, scales, and units.
	Give summaries of data that you observed during the experiment or investigation.
	Indicate where you conducted research for supporting details (i.e., library, Internet, interviews
	in special locations).
5. Note	e your conclusions.
	State your major findings clearly in key points.
	Offer supporting details from accepted theories and reference materials.
	Indicate your source for each detail, and use a proper citation.
	Tell how you know each source is authoritative, objective, factual, and valid.
	Underline headings and sub-headings in your report, using a ruler.
	Check your final write-up for factual accuracy, grammar, and spelling.
