3.6 Add and Subtract Polynomials

Adding Polynomials

Example:

a) Simplify: $(3x + 4y) + (2x - 5y)$

b) Simplify: $(2a - 3b) + (5a + 7b) + (3a - b)$

Solution:

a)
$$\begin{aligned}(3x + 4y) + (2x - 5y) &= 3x + 4y + 2x - 5y \\ &= 3x + 2x + 4y - 5y \\ &= 5x - y\end{aligned}$$

b)
$$\begin{aligned}(2a - 3b) + (5a + 7b) + (3a - b) &= 2a - 3b + 5a + 7b + 3a - b \\ &= 2a + 5a + 3a - 3b + 7b - b \\ &= 10a + 3b\end{aligned}$$

Practice:

1. Simplify: $(8c - 5d) + (5c + 8d)$

2. Simplify: $(2x^2 - 3x + 1) + (3x^2 + 4x + 2)$

Answers:

1. $13c + 3d$

2. $5x^2 + x + 3$
