
Add and Subtract Fractions

To add fractions with like denominators, add the numerators. Each fraction in the sum is a proper fraction, because the denominator is greater than the numerator.

To subtract fractions with unlike denominators, use a common denominator. This is a common multiple of the denominators.

Write the answer in lowest terms.





Add and Subtract Mixed Numbers

A mixed number includes a whole number and a fraction.

$$1\frac{3}{8} + 2\frac{7}{8} = 3 + \frac{10}{8}$$

$$= 3 + \frac{8}{8} + \frac{2}{8}$$
 Write the **improper fraction** as a mixed number.
$$= 3 + 1 + \frac{2}{8}$$

$$= 4\frac{1}{4}$$

$$= 4\frac{2}{8}$$

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To subtract mixed numbers, use a common denominator.

$$4\frac{1}{2} - 2\frac{3}{4} = 4\frac{2}{4} - 2\frac{3}{4}$$

If the second fraction is bigger than the first, use one of the following methods.

Use an Improper Fraction

Use Regrouping

$$4\frac{2}{4} - 2\frac{3}{4} = \frac{18}{4} - \frac{11}{4}$$
$$= \frac{7}{11}$$

$$= \frac{7}{4}$$
$$= 1\frac{3}{4}$$

Regroup 1 whole from $4\frac{2}{4}$.

$$4\frac{2}{4} = 3 + \frac{4}{4} + \frac{2}{4}$$
$$= 3 + \frac{6}{4}$$

$$3\frac{6}{4} - 2\frac{3}{4} = 1\frac{3}{4}$$

Subtract the whole numbers and subtrac the fractions.

Order of Operations

The **order of operations** is the correct sequence of steps for a calculation.

$$30 - 14 \div (5 - 3) \times 4 + 6$$

$$= 30 - 14 \div 2 \times 4 + 6$$

= $30 - 28 + 6$

Multiply and divide, from left to right.

Add and subtract, from left to right.
