Ongoing Assessment

- Upon completing the Chapter Review, students can also answer questions such as
 - Did you work by yourself or with others?
 - What questions did you find easy? Which were difficult? Why?
 - How often did you have to check the related Example in the text to help you with the questions? For which questions?

Teaching Suggestions

- The Chapter Review is organized by chapter sections so that students know where to refer if they need reinforcement. It is designed to completely review the concepts studied in this chapter.
- One approach to the Chapter Review is to assign one section of the review to the class, have the students work on it individually, then compare their solutions with their partners. This provides the opportunity for students to discuss the solutions to the questions and resolve the problems they have had. Then, students repeat the process with the next section. For problems they can't solve, encourage students to check their notes or text for a similar problem. It will help some students to see a completed, written solution to a question.
- Alternatively, have the class work on the entire review either individually or in pairs.
- Once the Chapter Review questions have been completed, you may wish to assign the Practice Test (See Practice Test section).
- Encourage students to flag the questions that caused them the most problems, so they know where to focus when studying.
