## Ongoing Assessment

- Upon completing the Chapter Review, students can also answer questions such as the following:
  - Did you work by yourself or with others?
  - What questions did you find easy? Difficult? Why?
  - How often did you have to check the related teach example in the text to help you with the questions? For which questions?

## Teaching Suggestions

- The Chapter Review is organized by chapter sections allowing students to know where to refer back to if they have difficulty recalling the concepts needed. It is designed to completely review the concepts studied in this chapter.
- One approach is to assign one section of the Chapter Review to the class, have students work on it individually, then compare their solutions with a partner. This provides the opportunity for students to discuss the solutions and resolve any difficulties they may have had. Then, have students proceed to the next section and repeat the process.
- If students have difficulty, encourage them to refer to their notes or the student text for similar problems. When necessary, provide solutions for students who are struggling with particular questions.
- Alternatively, have the class work on the entire Chapter Review either individually or in pairs.
- Encourage students to flag the questions that caused them the most problems, indicating that these are the ones they will need to focus on when studying.
