Question 1

a) $\frac{1}{2} = 0.5$

b) $\frac{2}{5} = 0.4$

c) $\frac{7}{10} = 0.7$

d) $\frac{1}{4} = 0.25$

a) $0.5 \times 100\% = 50\%$

b) $0.4 \times 100\% = 40\%$

c) $0.7 \times 100\% = 70\%$

d) $0.25 \times 100\% = 25\%$

a) $\frac{12}{16} = 0.75,$
 $0.75 \times 100\% = 75\%$

b) $\frac{17}{20} = 0.85,$
 $0.85 \times 100\% = 85\%$

c) $\frac{9}{24} = 0.375,$
 $0.375 \times 100\% = 37.5\%$

d) $\frac{18}{36} = 0.5,$
 $0.5 \times 100\% = 50\%$

Question 4

- a) The possible outcomes for tossing a coin are heads and tails. The outcomes are equally likely.
- b) The possible outcomes for choosing a marker are red, blue, yellow, brown, and orange. Each outcome is not equally likely because there is not an equal number of each colour.

Question 5

- a) The possible outcomes for rolling a die are 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, and 6. The outcomes are equally likely.
- b) The possible outcomes for the spinner are 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5. The outcomes are not equally likely since the area for 1 or 2 is greater than the area given for 3, 4 or 5.

Question 6

- a) The possible outcomes for choosing one bead are red, black, green, yellow, and orange. The outcomes are not equally likely because there are more beads of some colours than others.
- b) The possible outcomes of spinning a wheel are Try Again, \$1, Candy, and Toy. The outcomes are equally likely since the sections are equal in area.
- c) The possible outcomes for choosing a path are Hiker's Lane, Amber's Alley, and Wilderness Walk. The outcomes are equally likely.
- d) Answers will vary. For example, consider M, A, R, and Y. The outcomes are equally likely. (If a name has two or more of the same letter, the outcomes may not be equally likely.)

Question 7

- a) The dog is the most popular type of pet.
- b) The least favourite choice of pet is the hamster.
- c) 13 students chose cat as their favourite.
- d) 7 students chose bird as their favourite.
- e) 50 students were surveyed altogether.
