

## Section 4.1 Art Link

This worksheet will help you with the Art Link on page 131.



Create a personal logo from triangles, rectangles, and circles. Your logo can resemble a person, animal, or thing.

- **1.** Draw two triangles, two rectangles, and two circles on a sheet of construction paper.
- **2.** Cut out the six shapes.
- **3.** If you wish, trade some of your shapes with students who have other colours of construction paper.
- **4.** Cut the shapes into halves or quarters of the original shape.
- **5.** Glue your shapes to another piece of paper to create your logo. You must use all of your shapes or their parts. Pieces may partially, but not completely, overlap.
- **6.** Decorate or colour your logo. Give it a name.
- 7. Label each part shape with its fraction, decimal, or percent equivalent.
